Kathryn has also worked for Penobscot County Jail, where she facilitated the development of a Mental Health Risk Assessment tool that is still used to this day. She is a registered Maine Guide.

Julie has been with Wellspring for over 12 years. She currently oversees the programming and treatment for the women that reside at Wellspring’s Treatment Facility. In this role she trained many childcare providers about the impact of substance abuse on the family.
