The Rural Outreach Advocate position is responsible for the coordination of community collaborations with a wide variety of community partners to identify, assess and appropriately respond to victims of domestic abuse in rural areas. The advocate will work to expand and enhance victim services in the rural areas of Penobscot and Piscataquis Counties.

The successful candidates will have experience with program development, knowledge of relevant community systems, and excellent organizational and communication skills. Experience working with people affected by abuse and with consensus decision-making is a plus. All staff participate in crisis intervention, advocacy and community response work.

This is a full-time position with a starting salary of \$30,867 per year plus generous benefits.
