The Legal Team supports work within the civil and criminal justice systems related to victims of domestic violence. The Team Leader position offers an opportunity for a collaborative leader who wishes to have a positive impact on the community and the lives of people affected by domestic violence.

The Team Leader is responsible for supervising staff and services within the team and serving as a member of the SRWA leadership team. The leadership team shares responsibility with the Facilitative Director for leading and managing the organization. The Legal Team Leader will foster and maintain SRWA organizational values of involvement and inclusion for members of their team. The position is based in Bangor, Maine and requires travel throughout the two-county service area.
